Explore and master the **Five Ws and One H** of journalism in a **one-year diploma course** focussed on the Built Environment.

It is tailored for students of architecture, design, urban planning, town planning and environment management and protection; to prepare them for a **career in journalism** as specialist reporters, opinion writers, columnists and editors. Or, in the **entrepreneurial spirit of Ahmedabad**, students can go solo, on their own.

It is meant, indeed, for **anyone** who wishes to take their BE ideas to the public square.

Classes are designed to **simulate the real world of journalism**. Lectures follow the format of **news conferences with Q&As**; students make **regular visits to BE hotspots and newsrooms of print, radio and TV outlets**.

They will work every day on a **lab newspaper, to be called The Grid**, which will challenge them as reporters, editors, designers and producers, with the same pressures of deadlines that face newsrooms around the world.

They will close the academic year with a **capstone project**.
