Dr Anunaya Chaubey, Provost, Anant National University, Creates Awareness About Design Thinking and Interdisciplinary Learning During Kashmir Visit

The sessions also explored how design thinking integrates multiple disciplines to solve problems, highlighting design as a mega discipline that unites the humanities, commerce and science. Furthermore, Dr Chaubey engaged with representatives from private schools across Srinagar and North Kashmir to explore collaborative opportunities to incorporate design thinking into school curricula.
